OBJECTIVES OF ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Recognizing the persistent and detrimental impact of ragging on the physical, psychological, and emotional well-being of students, and evaluating the need for a decisive institutional response, the Honourable Supreme Court of India, in *SLP No. 24295 of 2006* (dated 16 May 2007) and *Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009* (dated 8 May 2009), issued binding directives to all Higher Educational Institutions in the country. These directives mandate not merely the prohibition, but the strategic prevention and complete eradication of ragging in all its forms.

In alignment with this judicial mandate, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) enacts these regulations to critically address and dismantle any conduct—verbal, written, or physical—that degrades, intimidates, or coerces a fresher or any other student. Such conduct, whether intentional or arising from negligence, is evaluated as an unacceptable abuse of peer influence, capable of generating fear, shame, humiliation, or psychological harm, thereby impeding the learner's academic and personal development.

These regulations are designed not only as a compliance measure, but as a deliberate, ethical commitment to fostering a campus environment where dignity, respect, and equality are upheld as non-negotiable values. By embedding preventive strategies, disciplinary frameworks, and awareness initiatives, this policy aspires to evaluate and continuously improve institutional culture, ensuring the holistic and healthy development of all students.

What Constitutes Ragging:

For the purposes of these regulations, *ragging* shall be interpreted as any conduct—verbal, written, physical, or digital—that compromises the dignity, safety, or psychological well-being of a student. It includes, but is not limited to, the following:

1. **Verbal or Physical Intimidation** – Any conduct, whether through spoken or written words, gestures, or actions, that teases, humiliates, or treats a fresher or any other student with rudeness, thereby fostering an environment of hostility or disrespect.
2. **Disruptive or Rowdy Behaviour** – Engagement in aggressive, undisciplined, or unruly acts that cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm, or create an atmosphere of fear or apprehension in a fresher or any other student.
3. **Compulsion to Perform Undesired Acts** – Directing or coercing any student to undertake tasks or actions they would not ordinarily perform, resulting in shame, embarrassment, humiliation, or mental distress, and thereby adversely impacting their physical or psychological well-being.
4. **Interference in Academic Activity** – Any deliberate act by a senior or peer that disrupts or obstructs the academic participation, focus, or progress of a fresher or any other student.
5. **Exploitation of Academic Services** – Misappropriating the time, effort, or intellectual contribution of a fresher or any other student for academic work intended for an individual or group, thereby undermining principles of academic integrity and self-reliance.
6. **Financial Exploitation** – Imposing financial extortion, coercive monetary demands, or any forceful expenditure on a fresher or any other student, thereby creating undue economic burden and violating their right to financial autonomy.
7. **Physical Abuse** – Engaging in acts that inflict physical harm or endanger health, including but not limited to sexual abuse, sexual harassment, homosexual assault, stripping, or coercing involvement in obscene, lewd, or indecent acts or gestures.

8. **Psychological or Digital Harassment** – Using spoken words, written messages, emails, social media posts, or other public channels to insult, humiliate, or cause distress to a fresher or any other student. This includes deriving perverse, vicarious, or sadistic pleasure from actively or passively participating in another student's discomfort.
9. **Acts Undermining Mental Health or Self-Confidence** – Any conduct, with or without malicious intent, that diminishes the self-esteem, mental health, or confidence of a fresher or any other student, particularly when motivated by a display of power, authority, or superiority.

Measures for Prevention of Ragging:

In strict compliance with the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India and the AICTE Anti-Ragging Regulations, it is **mandatory** for every Technical Institution, University, and Deemed-to-be University imparting technical education to implement the following preventive measures. These measures are not merely procedural requirements but deliberate institutional strategies to safeguard student welfare and uphold a culture of dignity, respect, and safety.

1. **Explicit Declaration in Admission Communications**

All admission-related advertisements, notifications, and publications—whether issued by the institution, affiliating University, admission authority, State Government, Union Territory, or Central Government—shall **clearly state** that ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. They must also specify that any individual found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging will be subject to prescribed disciplinary and legal action.

- o The *Prospectus*, admission brochures, and instruction booklets must prominently display the Supreme Court's directives and AICTE regulations on anti-ragging.
- o Affiliating authorities must ensure that all institutions under their jurisdiction incorporate this mandatory declaration.

2. **Affidavit by the Student:** The admission/enrolment application form shall include a pre-printed affidavit, preferably in English, Hindi, and/or the relevant regional language, to be duly filled and signed by the applicant. This affidavit shall affirm:
 - o The applicant's awareness of the laws prohibiting ragging and the corresponding punishments.
 - o The applicant's agreement to comply with these provisions and acceptance of disciplinary action if found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging.
3. **Affidavit by the Parent/Guardian:** The application form shall also include a **separate affidavit** for the parent/guardian, in the same language format, affirming:
 - o Awareness of the anti-ragging laws and punishments.
 - o Agreement to accept the disciplinary action imposed on their ward if found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging.
4. **Behavioural Record Verification:** Every admission application must be accompanied by a **behavioural report** from the applicant's previous institution, included with the School Leaving Certificate or Character Certificate. This report will enable the admitting institution to maintain heightened monitoring of students with adverse behavioural entries.
5. **Hostel Accommodation Affidavit:** Applicants seeking hostel accommodation shall submit a **separate affidavit** declaring awareness of the anti-ragging laws and acceptance of the punishments prescribed in the event of being found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging.
6. **Maintenance of Affidavit Records:** All institutions shall maintain **secure records** both physical and digital of all affidavits obtained from students and parents/guardians. Digital copies must be preserved in a retrievable format and made available to AICTE or its designated agency upon request.
7. **Centralised Digital Affidavit Database:** AICTE, or its designated agency, along with affiliating universities and the State/UT Directorate of Technical Education, shall maintain a secure, centralised digital repository of all student and parent affidavits collected at the time of admission.

8. **Faculty Mentorship of Freshers:** Each incoming batch of freshers shall be divided into small, manageable groups, with each group assigned to a faculty member. The mentor shall maintain **daily one-on-one interaction** with each student in the group to identify and address any difficulties—academic, social, or emotional—and provide timely guidance.
9. **Hostel Monitoring Protocol:** For freshers residing in hostels, the group mentor shall coordinate closely with hostel wardens and conduct **unscheduled visits** to ensure safety. Wherever possible, freshers shall be accommodated in a **separate hostel block**. If such segregation is not feasible, strict access control shall be enforced to prevent unsupervised contact with senior students.
10. **Professional Counselling and Induction Coordination:** Institutions shall engage professional counsellors during admissions to help freshers adjust to academic and hostel life. At the start of the academic session, the Head of the Institution shall convene a **multi-stakeholder meeting**—including wardens, faculty, student representatives, parents, and district administration (including police)—to coordinate anti-ragging measures.
11. **Freshers' Information Booklet:** Every fresher shall be provided with a printed handbook containing:
 - Names, addresses, and contact details of wardens, the Head of the Institution, anti-ragging committee members, and relevant district/police authorities.
 - Clear escalation procedures for seeking help in emergencies.
12. **Orientation and Induction Arrangements:** The handbook shall outline the institution's induction programme, explaining the systems and facilities designed to integrate freshers into campus life effectively and without intimidation.
13. **Rights and Protection Assurance:** The handbook shall clearly inform freshers of their rights, emphasising that they must **refuse participation in any activity against their will**, and reassuring them that the institution will protect them against any form of harassment or coercion.
14. **Academic Calendar of Engagement:** The handbook shall include a **calendar of events**—academic, cultural, and extracurricular—designed to familiarise juniors with the campus and foster positive peer interaction.

15. **Awareness through Visual Communication:** Large, prominently displayed posters outlining anti-ragging laws, punishments, and student support services shall be placed on notice boards, hostel entrances, and vulnerable areas. A portion of these posters shall be of **permanent, weather-proof design** in high-risk locations.
16. **Collaboration with Media:** Institutions shall actively engage with media outlets to publicise anti-ragging laws, institutional policies, and penalties, reinforcing the zero-tolerance stance to a wider audience.
17. **Identification and Control of Vulnerable Areas:** All potentially high-risk locations shall be identified, well-lit, and continuously monitored. Security shall be intensified during the early academic months, with **police presence where necessary**.
18. **Pre-Session Awareness Campaign:** During the vacation period before the academic year begins, institutions shall conduct an **awareness drive** using posters, seminars, street plays, and information booklets to sensitise both new and returning students.
19. **Special Induction Provisions:** Faculties and departments shall prepare induction plans tailored to address **special needs** of specific student groups, ensuring inclusivity and equitable participation.
20. **Communication Access for Freshers:** Freshers shall be allowed to keep mobile phones and communication devices in residential areas, ensuring uninterrupted access to parents, faculty, and institutional authorities for support and reporting.

OPERATIONAL MEASURES FOR PREVENTION AND DETERRENCE OF RAGGING

- **Freshers' Awareness Initiatives** – Implement structured awareness programmes for freshers, clearly explaining the legal definition of ragging, the institutional zero-tolerance stance, and the support mechanisms available for their protection.
- **Sensitisation of Senior Students** – Conduct formal sessions with senior students to critically analyse the ethical, academic, and legal consequences of ragging, highlighting the severe punishments prescribed under law and institutional policy.
- **Strategic Display of Anti-Ragging Information** – Install prominently placed anti-ragging notices and visual materials across academic blocks, hostels, libraries, canteens, sports facilities, and other high-traffic locations to reinforce the institution's commitment to eliminating ragging.
- **Unscheduled Hostel Inspections** – Conduct surprise inspections of hostel premises, particularly during early academic months, to detect and deter any attempts at ragging.
- **Random Campus Surveillance** – Undertake periodic surprise checks in classrooms, laboratories, canteens, playgrounds, transport facilities, and other congregation points to maintain a visible deterrent presence and ensure compliance with anti-ragging norms.

- **Orientation and Conduct Guidance** – Proactively inform and guide freshers on campus life, institutional culture, and expected standards of behaviour within classrooms, laboratories, hostels, and in all interactions with peers, faculty, and members of the public.
- **Incident Reporting and Direct Intervention** – Promptly report any ragging-related incident, regardless of severity, to the Institutional Anti-Ragging Committee. Where necessary, directly intervene to stop ongoing acts of ragging in accordance with institutional protocols.
- **Confidence-Building Among Freshers** – Foster a sense of safety and trust among new students while simultaneously creating a strong deterrent for senior students through visible enforcement of anti-ragging norms.
- **Support to the Anti-Ragging Committee** – Collaborate fully with the Institutional Anti-Ragging Committee in implementing the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court, AICTE, and affiliating authorities, promoting an ethos of compassion, respect, and cooperation from senior students towards juniors.
- **Case Reporting Protocol** – Submit timely and detailed reports of all ragging-related incidents and preventive measures undertaken to the Anti-Ragging Committee for record and action.
